Sign In Before Golfing and Swimming

Geneseo Country Club requires everyone to register at the Pro Shop before teeing off or swimming.

Golf Etiquette

Always **replace your divots** on the fairway right away. Doing this keeps the golf course looking nice and may stop another player's ball from landing in the hole the divot made.

Always rake the sand in the bunker after you have hit your ball out. Be sure to rake over the area where you hit your shot as well as any footprints that may be in the bunker.

When you **fix the ball mark** on the green where your ball has landed, take the time to fix at least two other ball marks. Doing this will help the green look its best.

Slow groups will allow **faster groups to play** through.

Golf Cart Rule:

There will be no more than one power cart per twosome, two power carts per threesome or foursome, and three power carts per fivesome. A maximum of three powers carts is permitted for each group.

RESERVED TEE TIMES:

Reserved tee times apply for Men's, Ladies' and Two-Ball League play. The following reserved tee times apply from May 1 to the date the League Ends.

Reserved tee times do not apply on July 4.

LADIES: 3:00 pm. to 6:00 pm. on Wednesdays.

MEN: 3:00 9m. to 6:00 pm. on Thursdays.

Two Ball: 4:00 pm on Fridays

All other players must be off the golf course by 3:00 pm. on Wednesdays and Thursdays.
